ALCOHOL BEVERAGE GUIDELINES

The Town of Van Buren places top priority on the safe and legal use of alcoholic beverages.

- Alcohol beverages may be brought in, dispensed and consumed **ONLY** in the picnic shelters for which you have a reservation.
- No person under the legal drinking age may possess or consume alcoholic beverages in any Town of Van Buren park.
- Alcoholic beverage consumption or open containers of alcoholic beverages are **prohibited** in all parking areas, roadways, and on or near the softball fields, basketball, volleyball and tennis courts.
- For obvious reasons, we would appreciate glass containers being kept to a minimum; ie., only for wine coolers, wine and liquor. Beer and soda should be in plastic, cans, or kegs. NO GLASS WHATSOEVER is allowed in the pool area. Thank you for your cooperation.
- The alcohol guidelines below are merely the maximum amounts of allowed on park premises during your group's event. These guidelines are not to be construed as endorsing the consumption for any group or individual, nor to suggest a "safe" level of consumption for any group or individual, nor to suggest that there is any "safe" level of alcohol consumption.
