

Pavilion A

SMALL PAVILION "A" --- is an open-sided, roof-covered shelter. There are six (6) picnic tables (seating 36) and one (1) large BBQ grill. Restroom facilities can be found at the bathhouse. No running water or electricity is provided at this shelter.

Pavilion "A" is on the Canton Street side of the park, near Van Buren Pool. It is smaller than the other three small pavilions on the "pond side" of the park.

Caterers are not permitted at Pavilion "A".

**** NOTE:** Parking for Pavilion "A" is in the main parking lot (main entrance off Canton Street). All vehicles must be kept on paved areas. Driving or parking on the grass is not permitted!

Rental Fees: Pavilion "A" = 30.00 for residents and \$45.00 for non-residents

Pavilion B

PAVILION "B" --- is open on three sides. At this shelter there are 18 picnic tables (seating 108), one large BBQ grill (45"X 51") and electricity. Caterers are welcome. The electric service at the Large Pavilion is normal household current ONLY. If more power is needed, groups/caterers should bring a generator. Pavilion B now has running water. Restroom facilities are not located at this shelter – they can be found at the Van Buren Pool bathhouse (right next door).

**** NOTE:** Patrons may pull up to the facility to load/unload supplies, but must return vehicles to the main parking lot once loaded/unloaded! Caterers may park a vehicle right next to the facility for the duration of the event. All vehicles must be kept on paved areas. Driving or parking on the grass is not permitted!

Rental Fees for up to 149 people: \$150.00 for residents and \$170.00 for non-residents

Pavilions C & D

PAVILIONS "C & D" ---are open sided, roof-covered shelters, with 12 picnic tables (seating 72). There is one large barbecue grill and electricity (normal 110 household current ONLY). Both pavilions have running water. Restroom facilities can be found at the Van Buren Pool bathhouse (right next door).

Parking: Cars may be parked on the gravel area by this shelter, but once that area is full, parking is in the main lot. Driving or parking on the grass is not permitted!

Rental Fees for up to 149 people: \$125.00 for residents and \$145.00 for non-residents

Pavilions E & F

SMALL PAVILIONS "E" & "F"--- are open-sided, roof-covered shelters on the "Connors Road side" of the park, by the pond. At each there are six (6) picnic tables (seating 36) and one (1) large BBQ grill. Restroom facilities can be found at the Porta Johns nearby or at the bathhouse on the other side of the park by the pool. No running water or electricity is provided at these shelters.

Parking: Parking for Pavilions "E" and "F" is along the LEFT SIDE of the park roadway (ballfield entrance off Connors Road). Please refrain from pulling more than just the vehicle's front tires onto the grass.

Rental Fees for up to 149 people: Pavilions "E" & "F" = \$30.00 for residents and \$45.00 for non-residents

Pavilion G

SMALL PAVILION "G" --- is an open-sided, roof-covered shelter on the "Connors Road side" of the park, by the pond. At this pavilion there are six (6) picnic tables (seating 36) and one (1) large BBQ grill. Restroom facilities can be found at the Porta Johns nearby or at the bathhouse on the other side of the park by the pool. No running water or electricity is provided at this shelter.

Parking: Parking for Pavilion G is along the LEFT SIDE of the park roadway (ballfield entrance off Connors Road). Please refrain from pulling more than just the vehicle's front tires onto the grass.

Rental Fees for up to 149 people: Pavilion "G" = \$30.00 for residents and \$45.00 for non-residents

THE LODGE

THE LODGE --- is a completely enclosed building, seating 60-65. Within the building are restrooms, a kitchen area with a stove and refrigerator, 3 large sinks , a work space, and an area with ten (10) folding tables, 70 folding chairs, a fireplace (bring your own wood), electrical outlets and running water. Outside the building are nine (9) picnic tables and one (1) large BBQ grill (45"x51"). Caterers are welcome. The electric service in the Lodge is normal household current (110), with one 220 outlet in the kitchen area.

Parking: We allow single file parking along the "Lodge Road" (to the left, coming from Connors Road) ONLY IF CONDITIONS ARE DRY. Please pull on to the grass just far enough so that your rear tires clear the road. If rain is forecasted the day of your event, or if it rained one or more days prior, then you and your guests should park on the hill in the lot marked "LODGE PARKING". **Any car ruts left by a group due to improper parking will be charged against the groups's damage deposit!** The wide area directly in front of the Lodge is for emergency vehicles, and needs to be kept free of cars. If you wish to drive up to the Lodge door to drop off supplies, you will be allowed to do so; however, please move your car to an appropriate parking area afterwards. If necessary, we will allow one or two cars to remain directly in front of the Lodge to assist in transporting any elderly or physically challenged guests.

Rental Fees for up to 149 people: \$170.00 for residents and \$190.00 for non-residents

(October 1-April 15):

Rental Fees for up to 149 people: \$195.00 for residents and \$215.00 for non-residents
