# <u>Set public Hearing for Local Law B-2025 – Amending Chapter 200 of Code relating to Planned</u> Unit Development :

Ms. Lesniak explained that this proposed local law would reduce the minimum number of acres from 15 to ten for an area to be zoned Planned Unit Development.

126-25-039 Ms. Lesniak introduced proposed Local Law No. B-2025, titled "A Local Law Amending Chapter 200 of the Code of the Town of Van Buren, titled 'Town of Van Buren Zoning Regulations,' Relating to Planned Unit Development Districts", which was seconded by Mr. Burke:

**WHEREAS**, proposed Local Law B-2025 has been introduced and will be considered for enactment pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law; and

WHEREAS, Volume 6 N.Y.C.R.R., Sections 617.3 and 617 of the Regulations relating to Article 8 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law of New York (SEQRA), requires that as early as possible an involved agency shall make a determination whether a given action is subject to the aforementioned law; and

**WHEREAS**, no other agency has the legal authority or jurisdiction to approve or directly undertake the enactment of a local law in the Town of Van Buren.

# **NOW, THEREFORE,** it is

**RESOLVED AND DETERMINED**, that the enactment of proposed Local Law No. B-2025 is an unlisted action, the Town Planning Board is an involved agency and shall proceed on an uncoordinated basis in this matter for purposes of SEQRA review; and it is further

**RESOLVED AND DETERMINED,** that the Town Board shall conduct a public hearing as to the enactment of proposed Local Law No. B-2025 at the Van Buren Town Offices located at 7575 Van Buren Road in the Town of Van Buren on June 4, 2025 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, at which time all persons interested in the subject shall be heard.
